



KCCC Restart Plan 2020-21



Based on current information and the yellow status of Knox County, the Knox County Career Center will plan to open on time. School begins on August 17 for 10th and 11th grade students (All students report on Aug. 18.) per the adopted school calendar.

A determination will be made after further planning with administrators and staff whether KCCC will open utilizing the Traditional or Lab Based 5-day a week plans.

We are committed to our vision of preparing students for success with hands-on learning and the opportunity to obtain industry credentials. We are working closely with our local districts as we all work toward having plans that are agile enough to adjust as needed. We are preparing for a variety of delivery methods so that we can adapt to state guidelines and partner districts' plans.

- Bussing will be available based on typical partner school transportation arrangements.
- All IEP and 504 accommodations will be met as they relate to the learning model utilized.
- All students will be provided a school laptop/device.

- Staff will wear facial coverings.
- Hand sanitizer and/or handwashing stations will be readily available throughout the building and in classrooms and labs.
- Cleaning and sanitizing of the classrooms and buildings will take place throughout the day and in the evenings with a solution that is effective against COVID19.

- Students will be required to do a daily health assessment prior to reporting to school.
- Students will be required to wear facial coverings in common areas, hallways, school buses, and anytime social distancing* is not possible in classrooms and other areas. KCCC will provide one solid color mask to each student. Student facial coverings should follow the Student Handbook dress policy.
- *Social distancing of 3'-6' will be adhered to according to the recommendations by the American Academy of Pediatrics and the Knox Public Health Department based on current Knox County conditions.
