

Frequently Asked Questions Regarding the KCCC Restart Plan

- **Are you offering an all-remote learning option?**
- No. Our career technical lab programs are best experienced in a hands-on nature that will prepare our students for what they will encounter in their career fields. We do have online and remote learning plans that will be implemented schoolwide if necessary.

- **Why was your August 4th orientation cancelled?**
- The focus of our student orientation is to distribute schedules, take photos for student ID's, and to distribute other paperwork prior to school starting. We typically have a large crowd turn out that includes students, families, and other visitors. In working with local health officials and state guidelines for health & safety, we determined the best decision would be to cover the orientation items during the first few days with students.

- **Can students still travel to and from KCCC throughout the day to take courses elsewhere (ex. College Credit Plus)?**
- Yes. Students will need to do a health assessment prior to entering the building.

- **Can students take their academics remotely with their local school and attend KCCC for lab only?**
- This is possible. This is considered the "dual-school" option. This would require the students and families to communicate with their local school counselor to determine if this will work with their scheduling needs. Students should be aware that if schools are able to resume in a traditional manner at full capacity, they would still be enrolled at their local high school for academics.

- **Will students be able to participate in early job placement?**
- Yes, early job placement will still be an option.

- **Are students required to be tested for COVID or pass a physical exam prior to reporting to the first day of school?**
- No, students are not required to undergo a physical exam or be tested prior to reporting in August. All students and staff are required to do the daily health assessment prior to reporting to school each day.

- **If my local school district is in a "RED" county or is utilizing remote learning, can I still attend KCCC in person?**

- Yes. You will follow the education plan that KCCC is utilizing (in-person, hybrid, or remote).
- **How can I pay for school fees?**
- School fees can be paid over the phone by calling us at 740-397-5820.
- **How will students receive their school ID's?**
- Students will have their photo taken during the first few days of school. ID's will be issued soon after.
- **Do students need to have a KCCC parking pass on the first day?**
- No. Students can drive without a parking pass during the first few days of school. They can pick-up parking pass paperwork once they are in attendance.

- **When will students receive their schedules?**
- Students will report directly to their career tech lab when they arrive on their first day. They will receive their full class schedules at that time.
- **Are students required to provide their own device for remote learning?**
- No. Students will be issued a KCCC device along with a school email and login information on their first day in attendance.
- **Is Monday a structured day for online learning or a catch-up day?**
- While in the Hybrid Lab Family Plan, Mondays will not be structured with student logins at regularly scheduled times. The days will be guided by teachers for students to catch up, reinforce, or enrich their learning with different projects, assignments, etc. Students will still be required to login to Home Room by 8:10am or call in for attendance purposes.
- **How will attendance be counted if a student has to self-quarantine?**
- During the Hybrid Lab Family Plan, students will still be required to login to their classes, login for attendance, and complete lab assignments when they are healthy enough to do so.
- **Where do they report on the first day of school?**

- Students will report to their career tech labs when the doors open at 7:45am. Bus riders will be admitted to the building when the bus arrives, and those students will report to the cafeteria where they will have assigned seats by school with social distancing measures in place.

- **How will the transportation work?**
- Transportation will operate in the same manner as in the past. The local districts within our CTPD will bus students from their local school to KCCC. Students can drive to school and park in the back student parking lot.

- **How do the online classes work?**
- All instructors will be using Google Classroom as the starting point for lessons and assignments. On remote learning days, students will be required to login to their academic classes at the regularly scheduled times. All assignments will be submitted electronically.

- **Will students be taking online classes all day on remote learning days or only during the periods they would normally be in school?**
- On remote learning days, students will be required to login to their academic classes at the regularly scheduled times. During the time they are typically in their lab program, they will not be required to login for instruction, but they may use this time to complete assignments. Students will be required to login to Home Room or call the school by 8:10am and verify their attendance.

- **Will students be required to wear masks all day?**
- Yes.

- **What if my student is on an IEP and needs extra help?**
- All IEP and 504 accommodations will be met as they relate to the learning model utilized in all KCCC learning plans.

- **What is the procedure if a student or staff member tests positive for COVID-19?**
- We will follow the protocols set by Knox Public Health.
