WELCOME

We would like to welcome your child to the Knox County Career Center Public Preschool where we can make a positive difference in your child's life.

Our classroom is designed to offer challenging play and learning choices in a developmentally appropriate setting. The keystone of our program is active learning in which the child is given the role of questioning, probing, exploring and planning.

We give each child the opportunity to explore in our center-based program. Our comprehensive curriculum is designed to nurture your child in:

Emotional Development; Social Development; Cognitive Skills; Language and Communication; Gross and Fine Motor Skills; Computer Skills; Dramatic Play; Music and Rhythm; and Art and Creativity.



We provide a safe, healthy and stimulating environment for children who are three, four and five years old. A warm and caring staff will encourage your child's natural curiosity and creativity.

Our head teacher has a Master's Degree in Early Childhood Education and is certified to teach Preschool through Fifth grade.

Our classroom has three teacher assistants and grandparent volunteers, who provide support for our program.

We benefit from the collaboration with the Knox County Career Center Early Childhood Education Students (junior and senior high school students), who help develop weekly lesson plans, themes and teaching the preschoolers. We also benefit from collaborations with different labs in the Career Center such as: landscape and design, cosmetology, practical nursing, ROTC and health tech (to name a few programs).

Our program operates Monday through Thursday, from either

8:00—11:15 am or 12:00—3:15 pm

To assist families with childcare needs, the morning class children can arrive as early as 7:30 a.m. There is an additional fee for morning childcare hours.

Since our public preschool is partially funded through a grant from the Ohio Department of Education, our tuition is based on a sliding fee scale, which is determined by income and family size. The scale is listed on the back of this brochure. Anyone who falls below 200% of the poverty level will have a decrease in full tuition.
