Acceptable Education, Training and Experience:

LPN to RN Program Requirements [4723-5-10]

- Completion of an approved registered nursing education program in a jurisdiction as defined in paragraph (P) of rule 4723-5-01 of the Administrative Code;
- Experience for at least two (2) years in the practice of nursing as a registered nurse;
- A master's degree (if the individual does not possess a bachelor of science in nursing degree, the master's or other academic degree, including but not limited to a Ph.D. shall be in nursing); and
- Current, valid unrestricted licensure as a registered nurse in Ohio.

PN Program of Study [4723-5-11]

- Completion of an approved registered nursing education program in a jurisdiction as defined in paragraph (P) of rule 4723-5-01 of the Administrative Code;
- Experience for at least two (2) years in the practice of nursing as a registered nurse;
- A baccalaureate degree in nursing; and
- Current, valid unrestricted licensure as a registered nurse in Ohio.

Requirements for all nursing faculty

- State of Ohio Adult Education Teaching Permit.
- Current CPR/AED certification, TB skin test and Hepatitis vaccine.
- Other combinations of experience and education that meet the minimum requirements may be substituted.
- Satisfactory FBI and BCI background check, drug test, and reference check.

Description: The purpose of this position is to instruct nursing students at the postsecondary level to adult learners who are pursuing an occupation in nursing. Instruction will be delivered in classroom, laboratory and/or clinical settings. This is a part-time position and does not include benefits.

Essential Functions:

1. Provide a course syllabus in accordance with accreditation standards and is in compliance with law and rule.
2. Design and implement teaching strategies that will assist a nursing student to meet the course objectives or outcomes.
3. Direct and supervise the activities of a teaching assistant, if utilized.
4. Evaluates learner's performance and progress in the classroom, laboratory and clinical settings.



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All experiences for a nursing student in a clinical setting involving the delivery of nursing care to an individual or group of individuals must be performed under the direction of a faculty member who functions only as a faculty member during the nursing student's clinical experience. The faculty member providing direction of clinical experiences will:

5. Establish clinical objectives or outcomes within the framework of the course in which the student is enrolled.
6. Communicate clinical objectives or outcomes.
7. Supervise student learners practice in the clinical and laboratory settings.
8. Evaluates learner's performance and progress in the clinical settings.
9. Direct and supervise the activities of a teaching assistant or preceptor if utilized.
10. Maintain faculty to teaching assistant ratios for direct patient care experiences.
11. Ensure teaching assistant and / or preceptor competence in the area of clinical practice.
12. Reinforce learning.
13. Keeps records of learner progress.
14. Counsel individual learners.
15. Serve as liaison between school and clinical agency.
16. Serve as role model.
17. Develop teamwork.
18. Foster professional relationship with learners.
19. Participate in the development of the educational program.
20. Participate in program improvement.
21. Maintain professional and technical knowledge and engages in professional development.
22. Maintain organized, safe and clean work environment that is conducive to learning.
